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- 1. Download the patterns from the website (www.fivesdesigns.com): (i) the full pattern and (ii) 6-sub-patterns, each of which is part of the full pattern.
- 2. Divide students into 6 groups. (Full pattern may be broken into more/fewer sub-patterns as necessary.)
- 3. Assign each group one sub-pattern to build. *Important*: ensure that students are all building their section in the same orientation, otherwise the parts will not connect together at the end. For example, tell students that the FIVES tiles should be oriented with the holes on the bottom and right-hand sides.
- 4. Once all sections are completed, have students work together to assemble the pieces into a single, large butterfly.
